

Teas and Infusions

English Breakfast

Broken orange pekoe loose tea blend from Assam & Ceylon. Based on the traditional recipe and is composed of 50% select high grown Ceylonese tea with a balance of our highly aromatic Assam teas. A fine spicy full of flavour morning tea.

Xian Ming China Green

This is a fantastic looking Chinese Green Tea. In Chinese it means “Fragrant”.The leaf is long and twisted, dark green in colour entwined with young downy buds. The liquor is light and bright with a distinct floral, peachy note.

Darjeeling

Hi grown flowery orange pekoe from the "Lingia" Estate in the foothills of the Himalayas, the champagne of tea. Darjeeling . The name Lingia is derived from the word Lin-ge which in the language of the Lepcha means "triangle of eight mountain tops".

Camomile flowers

Finest Italian camomile flowers. A member of the daisy family camomile has been used for centuries as a traditional remedy for gastronomical pains and complaints. It is a soothing tea for the end of the day as it has active relaxing ingredients.

Earl Grey

A Keemun, Assam and Darjeeling blended tea named after Lord Grey— British Prime minister in the 1830’s. Its distinctive flavour and aroma are derived from the addition of oil extracted from the rind of the bergamot orange which was originally added to preserve the tea on long trade routes..

Rooibos

Rooibos is Afrikaans for Red Bush !. The national beverage of South Africa. Rooibos Tea contains NO caffeine and only a small amount of tranic acid. Rooibos is a Herbal Tea / Tisane. Mainly grown in the Western Cape Province of South Africa. After picking the leaves are oxidised which produces the redish brown colour of leaf. It has a natural sweet flavour with a fruity note. A rich ruby appearance in the cup.

Ceylon

Orange tekoe large leaf from ‘the island of tea’, Black with an aromatic liquor & full, rich flavour. Ceylon Tea from Dimbula . One of Ceylons finest tea areas grown at about 5,000 feet above sea level. Dimbula’s are noted for their full bodied and strong flavours. This Single Estate loose leaf black tea has a rich and bright aromatic liquor and is full of flavour.

Peppermint

Peppermint Green Tea -High quality gunpowder teas are used here and blended with finest mint to give an intense natural crisp mint note to the flavour.

Fresh mint also available in season.

Lapsang Souchong

A blend of the finest quality loose tea, black Chinese in the ‘Fukien’ province. Interestingly when plucking Lapsang you don’t pick the new growths of two leaves and a bud but instead pluck the more mature, riper, larger leaves from the lower parts of the tea bushes. After fermentation the leaves are put on hot iron pans and roasted for a short time, and then the tea is smoked over exotic woods rich in resin.

White—Pai Mu Tan

A tea plant by the name of Chaicha or Narcissus lets this unusual tea grow in the province of Fujian and is also known as White Peony. After plucking the tea leaves are dried in the sun or in closed rooms without any technical aid. Its large long leaves appear as many shades of green with different structures and tips of silvery white. In the cup Pai Mu Tan Tea gives a shimmering amber tone with an elegant spicy taste.

Rosehip & hibiscus

Strong aroma & taste, striking reddish colour in cup Hibiscus fine cut herbal tea is an infusion made from the Hibiscus Sabdariffa flower . Caffeine free and good for lowering cholesterol and generally helping with losing weight and boosting the immune system.
